Part III: Significant Events/Situations(i.e., funding changes, financial outlook, and other) - Enrollment at all four ASU campuses has reached an enrollment of 64,394 students. All four ASU campuses experienced increases.
ASU had a record of 9,274 freshmen with 265 freshmen national scholars and 111 National Hispanic Scholars.
ASU established the world's first School of Sustainability. The Hispanic Business magazine listed ASU's College of Law 7th of the top 10 law schools in the country for Hispanic students. ASU ranked one of top 100 universities in the world by the Institute of Higher Education, Shanghai Jiao Tong University. ASU's Biodesign Institute received the highest designation - platinum - for environmental friendly design and construction from the US Green Building Council. ASU research expenditures grew to 218.5 million.
