There is an ongoing struggle between the Florida Board of Governors (BOG) and the State Legislature over control of tuition. The Legislature is also considering a reorganization of higher education governance in the State, with a proposed constitutional referendum to approve a new structure. The structure would establish an elected Commissioner of Education with authority over all educational sectors. The Florida economy is suffering some revenue shortfalls and some budget cuts are occurring within the State University System.
