The 2008 Florida Legislature passed a differential tuition bill. This bill allows select state universities to charge above the state mandated tuition rate. In FSU's case, we are capped at 40% above the State University System tuition rate, with no more than a 15% annual increase. FSU's Board of Trustees approved the 15% tuition increase for 2008-09.
