OSU hired a new president who started in Spring 2008.

---

State funding was basically level this year. This is the first year 4-year institutions in Oklahoma were mandated to offer an optional guaranteed tuition rate to instate new freshmen. OSU had 126 students (about 5.3% of our in-state new freshmen opt into this program.

---

Construction continues at OSU. However, our multi-modal transportation facility is in use and our new classroom building should be utilized for courses starting Spring 2009, as well as several other buildings being completed during Spring and Summer 2009.
