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A new funding formula for higher education was adopted in the last regular session. While not fully funded, it does attempt to acknowledge mission differences in institutions. A special session is anticipated to address a recent report by two masters on behalf of the Arkansas Supreme Court that states that the General Assembly did not put K-12 public ed as its top priority and cites both higher ed funding and the funding of local pet projects as evidence of that finding.
