Part III: Significant Events/Situations(i.e., funding changes, financial outlook, and other) - In Fall 2006, ASU at the Tempe campus enrolled 188 National Merit Scholars, placing the campus among national leaders. ASU also attracted 87 National Hispanic Scholars, the most ever. ASU at the Downtown Phoenix campus opened, enrolling students in its 3 colleges: Public Programs, Nursing and Healthcare Innovation, and University College. Hassayampa Academic Village, an integrated living learning community for students, opened on the Tempe campus. The second of 4 planned Biodesign Institute buildings was completed, as well as 2 new Interdisciplinary Science and Technology buildings. ASU's research expenditures surpassed \$200 million in FY 2006.
